
The Budget Committee has really helped keep P.H.S. in the clear financially by maintaining a tight grip on the school pursestrings. They have worked hard and have done their job well.

Through rivalries in the many sports, where we loved the Preston High Indians, whether they won or not.






### THE SPANISH CLUB LEARNED ABOUT THE SPANISH


